Thanks to you, these women are able to echo Mary's *yes*. They are able to joyfully embrace the Heavenly Father's plan for them, just as the Holy Family did.



Tyler and Rachel's Story

Rachel and I got married in 2018. It has always been our dream to start a family, so shortly after marriage we started trying to conceive. After a couple years of trying and countless visits to doctors and fertility clinics, we began pursuing adoption.

In 2021 we decided to try a national infant adoption. Our adoption profile started circulating to potential birth mothers throughout the country the following April.

A couple months later, my mother asked Rachel and me if she could share our profile with her old high school classmate who is involved with the Saint Gianna and Pietro Molla Maternity Home. We said yes.

Then we received a call that would change our lives forever. A young woman at the Saint Gianna and Pietro Molla Home wanted to meet us and potentially match for an adoption.

We met Mariana—the birth mother of our child—at a restaurant in early July. By the end of dinner, she had asked us to be the parents of her baby. Our beautiful Theodore was welcomed into the world two months later.

Theodore has been the light of our lives ever since. Not only have we welcomed a new son into our family, but we also have an ongoing relationship with Mariana.

We feel incredibly blessed to have been chosen to be Theodore's parents and are grateful for the gift of adoption!

Mariana's Story

In December of 2021, I found out I was pregnant. I was just 17 years old.

My mom and I called the Saint Gianna and Pietro Molla Maternity Home. Mary Pat was so understanding. We both felt at peace hearing her voice, and we asked a lot of questions about the Home.

Initially, I thought that I was going to parent, thinking I could do it all by myself with the support of family and friends. But then something more amazing unfolded.

One day, Mary Pat and I were having a discussion. I told her that I had decided to choose adoption for my son. At that moment, a notification on Mary Pat's phone interrupted us.

She opened a text and saw a video sent to her from a friend. The video was of a young couple looking for a child to adopt. I watched the video and loved them both instantly.


Mary Pat arranged a meeting with the couple. That evening is one I'll never forget. As we left dinner, I looked at them and said, "I would love to continue to meet and get to know you." I knew then without a doubt that they would be my baby's parents.

Every day I pray for him and his amazing parents, Tyler and Rachel. The unplanned pregnancy and the decision to choose adoption were so difficult for me. But choosing Theodore's family was easy. God was with me in these difficulties—I am at so much peace with this adoption.



What My Dad Taught Me About Being a Saint

We recently renamed Saint Gianna's Maternity Home to add in her devoted husband, Pietro. Here, the Mollas' daughter and our dear friend, Gianna Emanuela, shares some memories of her holy father.

During the forty-eight years that Dad lived without my Mom's visible presence, they went on to be "one heart and soul," very spiritually united and in communion with each other.

She helped him to carry his cross, day after day, and to realize God's will in a heroic way. Only two years after my Mom's death, my older sister, Mariolina, died at the tender age of 6, of an acute glomerulus-nephrite and kidney failure.

I remember that Dad prayed a great deal and continued thanking the Lord, for everything. I was surprised that, even though he had suffered tremendously during his long life, he always told me: *"Eternity will not be enough for me to thank the Lord for all the graces He granted me during my long life."* While living with him, I completely understood why my Saint Mom took example from him, and I learned what it means to be a "saint of everyday life." His life and writings reveal that his soul was totally immersed in God; that his unshakable faith permeated and strengthened every single aspect of his life.

How many times has my Dad repeated these words to me: "*Jesus Christ came on this earth to serve, not to be served, and we must do the same.*"

And since I was a child, I could understand very well the deep meaning of these words, because I have seen my holy Dad personally testify to this exhortation by his daily example.

He left me an extraordinary spiritual legacy, through his Christian and moral virtues.
